- School improvement goal of strengthening tier 1 practices for all students- focus on academic, behavior, and social emotional
  - o Academic: use of Amplify and progress monitoring, increase instructional practices
  - o Behavior: using common language, tracking data in EduClimber
  - o Social emotional: DESSA screener, celebrating successes (using the slide as a tool)

#### 4.2. High School Update

Mr. Voigt highlighted the following components of the site plan that they have been focused on for the start of the 24-25 school year:

- Goal 1: reduce percentage of behavior referrals per cohort/student over 3- years (strategy 5)
- Goal 2: increase graduation rate year-by-year over the next 3 years (strategy 4)
