 - New Central K-5 Elementary School

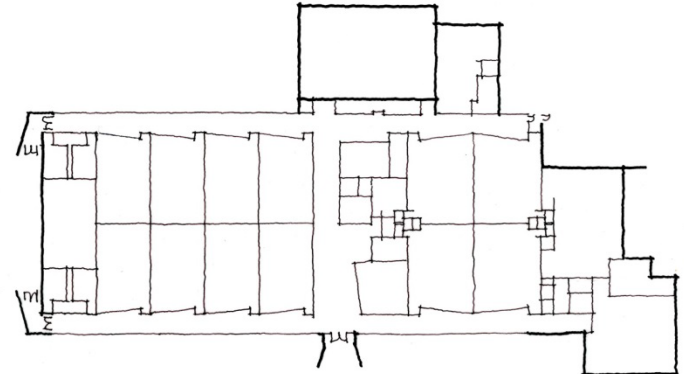
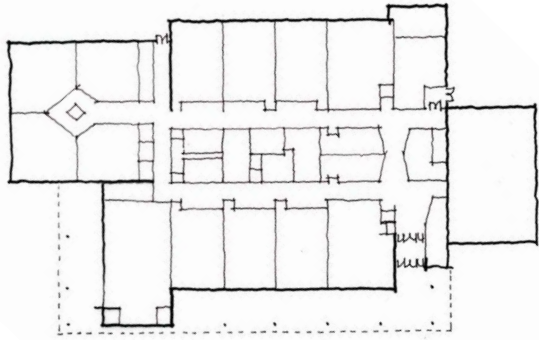
- **Option # 3A – Minimal Renovation – No Bond Issue**

 - Minimal renovation only of Stoddard Elementary 2-Unit K-5 School

- **Option # 3B - \$17.65M**

 - Renovation only of Paddock Lane Elementary 3-Unit K-5 School

 - Renovation only of Stoddard Elementary 2-Unit K-5 School

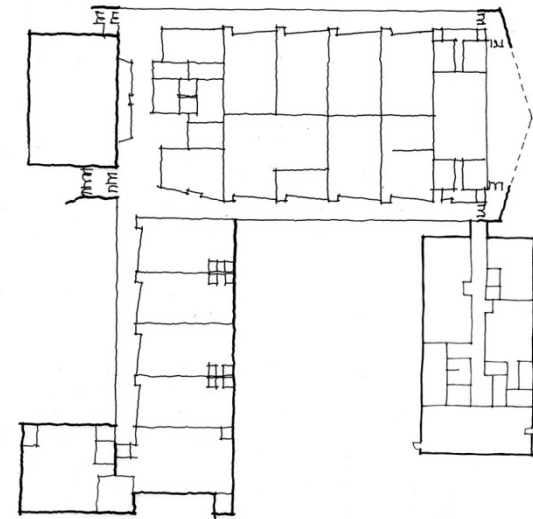
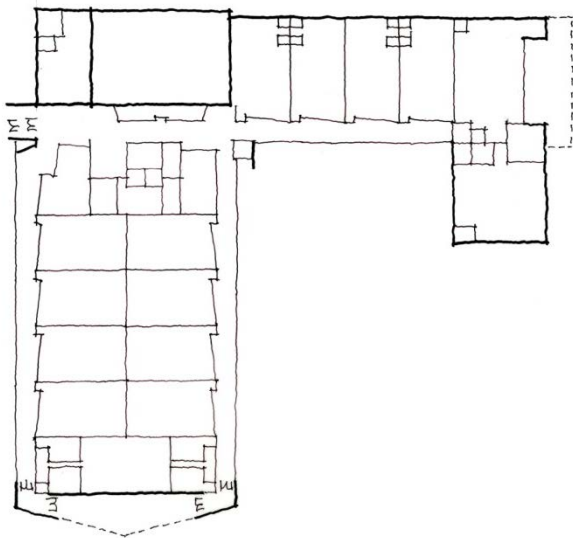

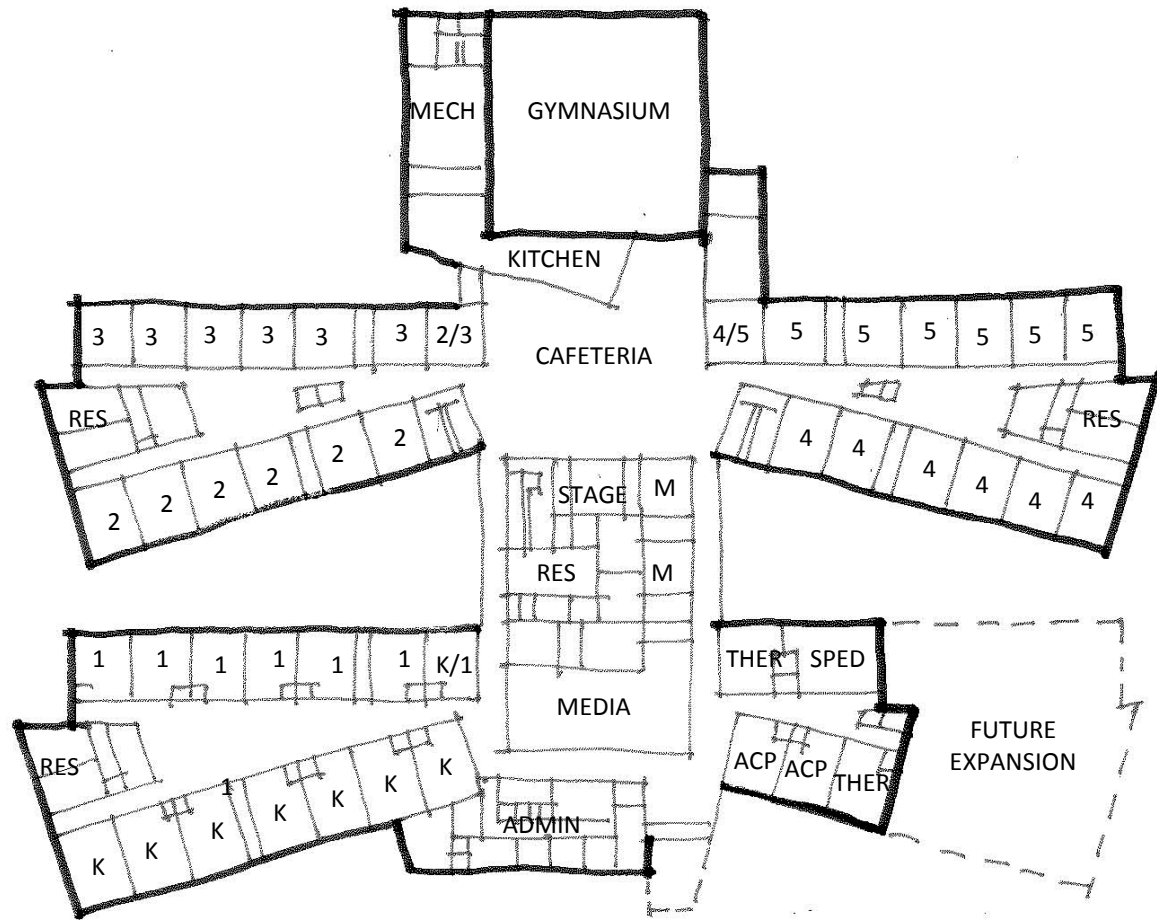
Option #1 – New PK-5 Building



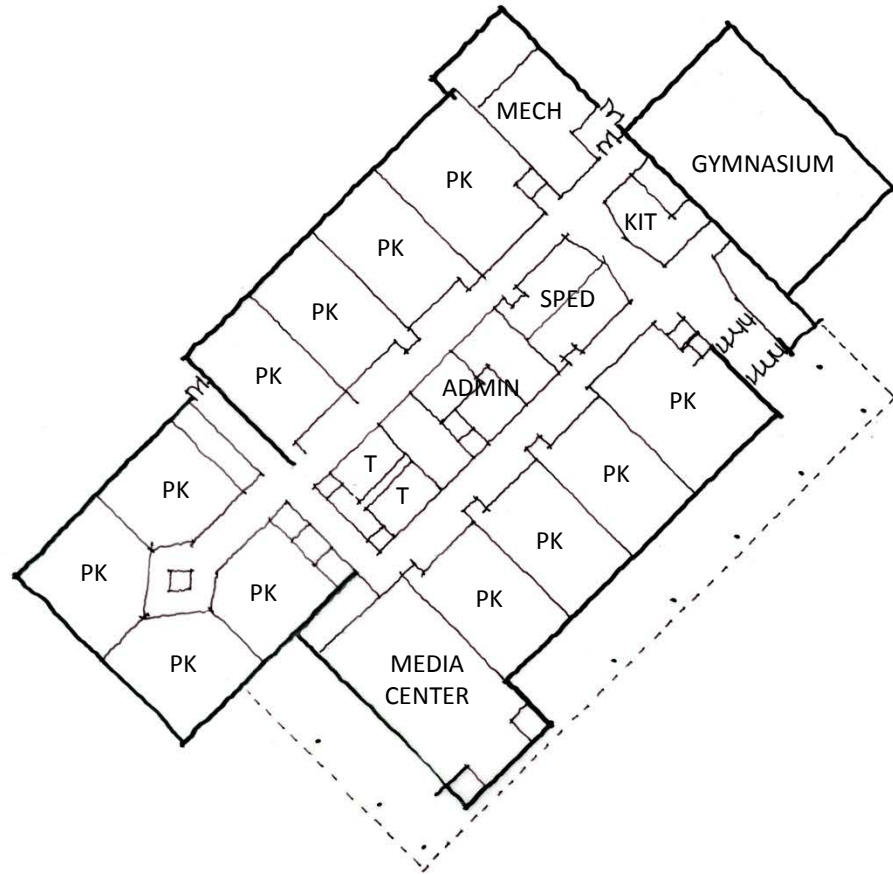
Any of the existing elementary schools
could be repurposed as the District PreK Center



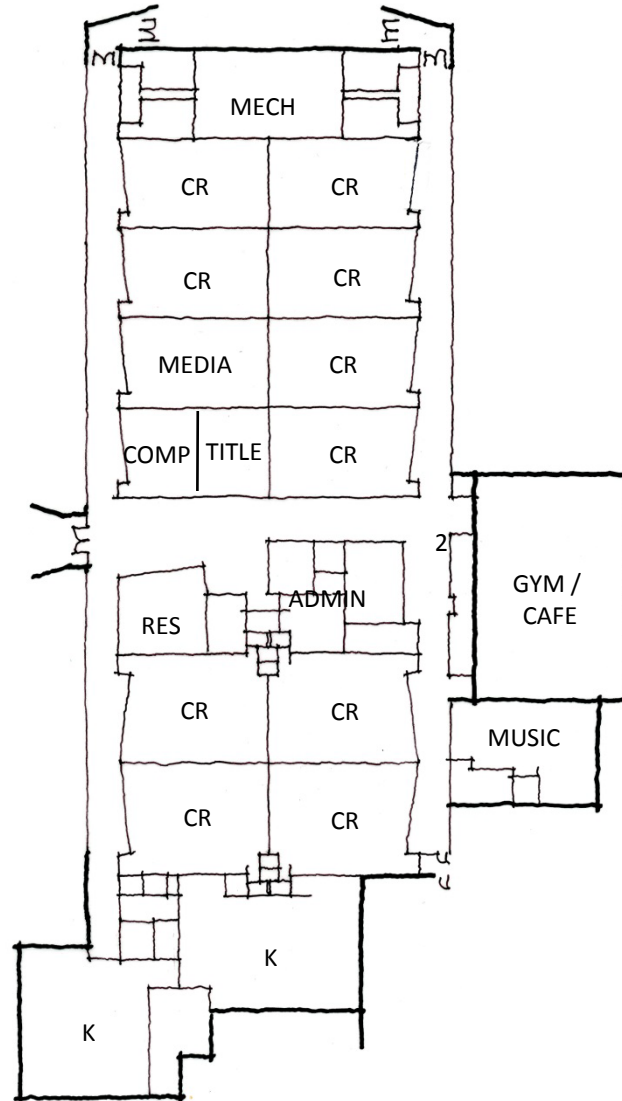
Option #2 - PreK Center



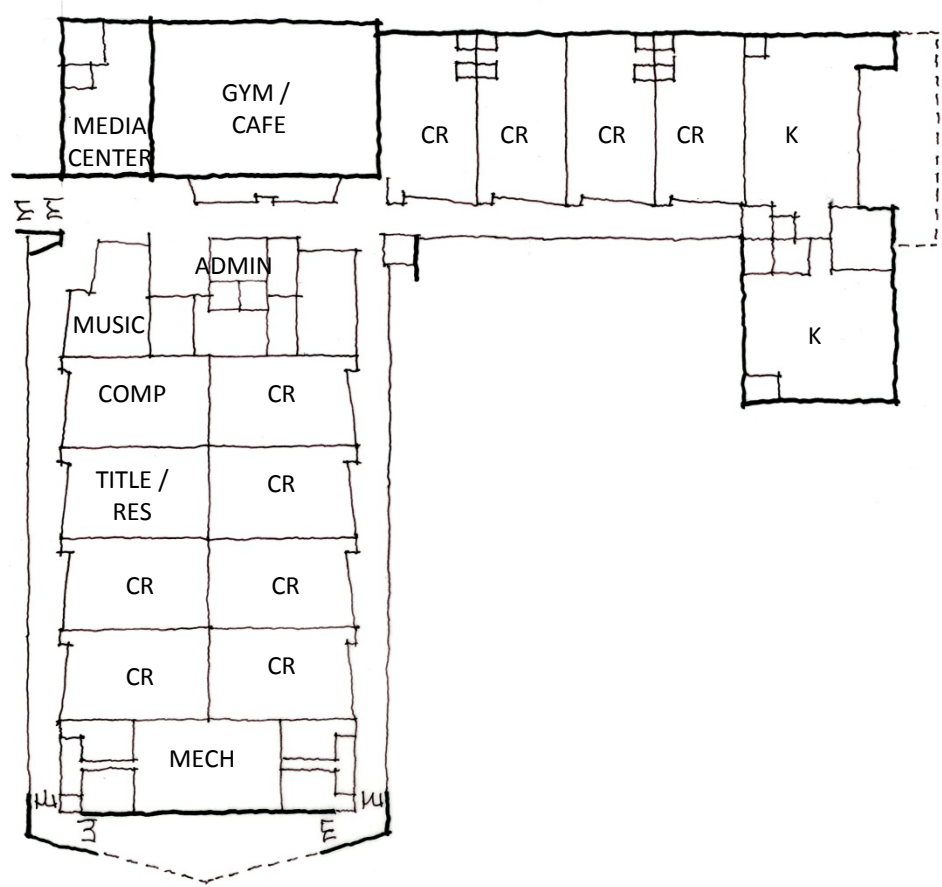
Option #2 – New K-5 Building

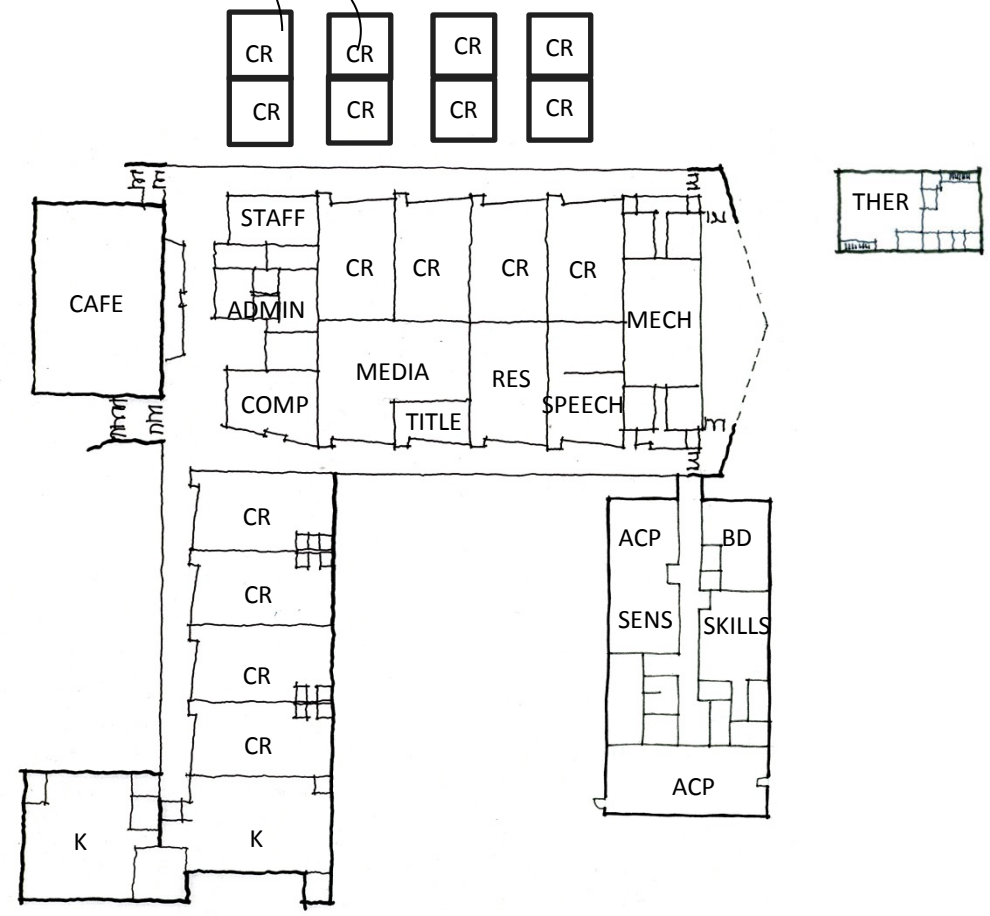


Option #3A, B & C – Lincoln 2-Unit K-5 Building

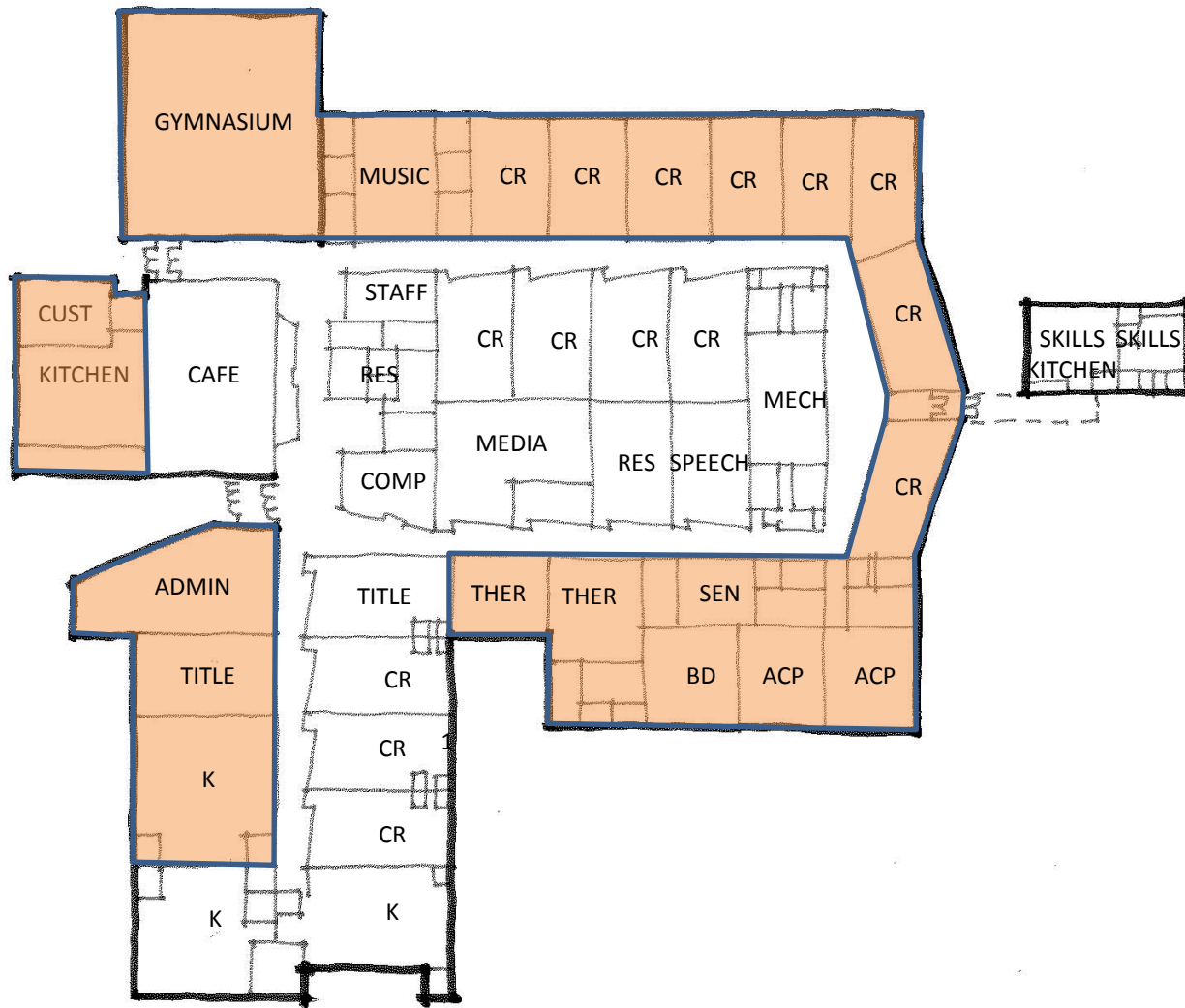
